Cosmology is undergoing a scientific revolution in process of creating a meaningful picture of the universe. Albrecht will give a basic outline of modern cosmology and give his perspective on some of the latest exciting developments. These include the Cosmic Microwave Background (aka the "edge of the observable universe") which was the subject of 2006 Nobel Prize as well as the "Dark Matter" and "Dark Energy", which together were recently named #1 on Science Magazine's list of 125 top problems in contemporary science.
