Lecturer*:
With PhD, \$46,668 (annual rate) x 2.75% x # units
(example: 4-unit course = \$5,133.48; 5-unit course = \$6,416.85)
With MS, \$43,336 (annual rate) x 2.75% x # units taught

Associate-Instructor: \$41,326 (annual rate) x 2.75% x # units
(example: 4-unit course = \$4,546; 5-unit course = \$5,682)

Teaching Assistant: PHY 7 \$4,538; PHY 9 lab support \$3,025; PHY 9 discussion \$1,513; AST 10L \$3,025

Reader: With baccalaureate \$12.72/hour; without baccalaureate \$12.08/hour
